**VNA FACT groups are held at the following locations:**

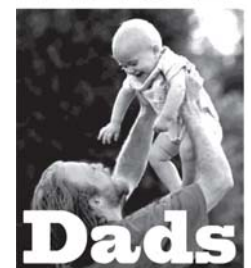
